Re: Number of Signatures Required for Countywide Initiative or Referendum Petition

---

Oregon law (ORS 250.205) requires that the number of active registered voters' signatures required to place an initiative or referendum measure on the ballot is based upon a percentage of the total votes cast in the county for all candidates for Governor at the last election in which a candidate for Governor was elected to a full term.

The current signature requirements are based on 28,256 voters in the 11/06/2018 gubernatorial election:

For an **initiative** (6%): **1,695 valid signatures required**

For a **referendum** (4%): **1,130 valid signatures required**

(A referendum petition must be filed no later than the 90<sup>th</sup> day after the adoption of nonemergency county measure).
