Re: Number of Signatures Required for Countywide Initiative or Referendum Petition

Oregon law (ORS 250.205) requires that the number of active registered voters' signatures required to place an initiative or referendum measure on the ballot is based upon a percentage of the total votes cast in the county for all candidates for Governor at the last election in which a candidate for Governor was elected to a full term.

The current signature requirements are based on 30,217 voters in the 11/08/2022 gubernatorial election:

For an **initiative** (6%): **1,813 valid signatures required**

For a **referendum** (4%): **1,209 valid signatures required**

(A referendum petition must be filed no later than the 90th day after the adoption of nonemergency county measure).
